



Anticoagulation Discontinuation Before Surgery

Before your surgery, please discontinue the anticoagulation medications until instructed otherwise by your doctor. If there are any questions or concerns, please contact Camarillo General Surgery.

Anticoagulation medications:

- **Aspirin** is to be discontinued **1 week before**
- **Antiplatelet agents: - Plavix/ clopidogrel, Brilinta/ticagrelor, Effient/ prasugrel, Persantine/ dipyridamole** is to be discontinued **1 week before.**
- **NSAIDS** are to be discontinued **1 week before.**
- **Aggrenox** is to be discontinued **10 days before.**
- **Pletal/ cilostazol** is to be discontinued **5 days before.**
- **Coumadin/ warfarin** is to be discontinued **5 days before.**
- **Eliquis/ apixaban** is to be discontinued **4 days before.**
- **Xarelto/ rivaroxaban** is to be discontinued **3 days before.**
- **Pradaxa/ dabigatran** is to be discontinued **3 days before.**
- **Edoxaban/ savaysa** is to be discontinued **3 days before.**
